A SYNOPSIS OF UPPER SIANG DISTRICT.

Upper Siang District was created by bifurcating erstwhile East Siang district in 1994. It was formally inaugurated by Shri Mata Prasad, the then Governor of Arunachal Pradesh on 12th May 1995 and become the 13th district of the state. The area of this district is approximately 6188 Sq Km. It is bordered by Mc Mohan Line in the north, Dibang Valley district in the east, Lower Dibang Valley districts in the south east, East Siang district in the south, Siang district in the west and Shi-Yomi district in the north west.

Historical Genesis

Upper Siang district was a part of Siang district, the name of which is derived from the river Siang. The beginning of administrative development of this area can be traced back to the Government of India, Foreign and Political department of 1914 wherein the area become part of central section of the North East Frontier Tract under the administrative control of the Political Officer. In the year 1919 the central section along with the Eastern Section of the same tract was renamed as the Sadiya Frontier Tract with its headquarters at Sadiya. In the year 1948 Sadiya Frontier Tract was bifurcated into two separate administrative charges namely Abor Hills District and Mishmi Hills District under the regulation of 1954, Abor Hills District was renamed as Siang Frontier Division.

In 1965 Siang Frontier Division was again renamed as Siang District and Political Officer was re-designated as Deputy Commissioner with Division headquarter at Along. In 1980 again the Siang district was divided into two districts, namely East Siang and West Siang district for administrative convenience. In 1994 again the East Siang district was divided into East Siang and Upper Siang.

Administrative Structure

At present, Upper Siang District has three Sub-Divisions namely- Yingkiong, Mariyang and Tuting which in turn are divided into circles. The district as a whole comprises of 11 circles namely-

The Deputy Commissioner cum District Magistrate is the head of the District and coordinates with all other departments for developmental activities as well maintains law and order with the help of Administrative Officers and Police force. Each of the 11 circles of the district is administratively controlled by a circle officer.

The Assam Frontier (Administration of Justice) Regulation, 1945 authorizes the village Council to settle all civil matters and certain criminal matters falling within their jurisdictions. This "Kebang System" (traditional political institution or council of elders) is an important feature in Adi dominated belt and is an effective alternate dispute resolution system.

The Panchayati Raj system has been implemented and consists of two tiers- namely:-

- 1) The Gram Panchayat at village and block level.
- 2) The Zilla Parishad at district level.

Physiography

Upper Siang District is a thinly populated hilly tract lying roughly between the latitude of 94° - 95° "N" and longitude 28° - 29° "E" having an area of roughly 6188 Sq. Km. The district is bordered by Mc Mohan Line in the north, Dibang Valley district in the east, Lower Dibang Valley districts in the south east, East Siang district in the south, Siang district in the west and Shi-Yomi district in the north west.

Topography of the district is wild mountainous area and presents a remarkable topographical variety. The altitude varies from 375 meters above sea level at Geku circle, 450 meters above sea level at Yingkiong to 1500 meters above sea level at Singa circle headquarter. The mighty Siang river originate from Tibet and flows through this district dividing it into two and joins the mighty Brahmaputra in the plains of Assam.



Climate

The climatic condition mostly moderate with humidity and plenty of rainfall. The temperature ranges between 19°C to 35.50°C ; the average temperature was 27.20°C in the year 2021. The average rainfall was 175.67 mm in the year 2021.

Flora and Fauna



The district is very rich in Flora and Fauna. The Mouling National Park is situated under Jengging Sub- Division. Many wild animals, birds and plants species like Takin, Clouded Bear, Sesow, Goral, Leopard etc. are found here. It is famous for the white feathered wild duck.

People



number of rituals and ceremonies locally called "ipak" by offering eggs, fowls and animals (like pigs and dogs) with the help of local priest called Miri. Sun (donyi), Moon (poko) considered as Supreme beings. Religious institutions like Donyi-Polo Gangging have been established. The Memba and Khamba profess Mahayana Sect of Buddhism. The Buddhist tribes have monastic institutions like Gompas, Vihars where regular prayers are held.



The major tribes found in this region are Adi followed by Membas, Khambas and very few Mishimis inhabit the high belt areas like Singa, which is also the remotest circle of the district. Adi dominated areas are Yingkiong sub-division and Maryang sub-division. Memba and Khamba are mainly found within Tuting sub-division. The sub-tribes of Adi's found in Upper Siang are Padam, Pasi, Minyong, Millang, Karko, Dalbing, Shimong, Komkar, Pang, Bogum Bokang etc.

Religion

The religious faith and belief of Adi's may be called as Animistic, as they believed in existence of Supernatural beings. They perform a



Festivals

The main festival of Adi community residing in Upper Siang district are Solung, Etor, Aran etc. Solung is celebrated usually on 1st September (or date may vary according to various sub-tribe) usually Mithun (Bosfrontalis) considered sacred and reared in semi-wild are sacrificed and rituals are performed to propitiate Solung deity. It is an agricultural festival celebrated for bumper cropping and prosperity of

the people. Ponung is the most popular and common dance performed by women folk during Solung festival.



Delong is performed by the men during Etor festival. The most popular dance of Adi tribe is warrior dance called "TAPU" performed by men folk.

The Losar is the new year festival of Memba and Khambas celebrated on 11th February. During the festival days a series of worship are performed by the lamas to have good life and to obtain blessing for the entire community for peace and prosperity. The festival is celebrated in the Buddhist temples namely Gompa. Different pantomime dances are performed by the male folks.

Places of Tourist interest

Mouling National Park: - It is situated under Jengging circle and covers area of 4873 Sq. Km. Many wild animals, birds and plant species are found here. The prime attraction are Takin, Clouded Bear, Sesow, Goral, White feathered wild duck, Leopard etc. The best time to visit is October to April.

Buddhist pilgrimage place: - There are many important Buddhist Pilgrimage places in the district, prominent among them are (1) Tsita Puri, believed to be abode of Guru Padma Sambhava (2) Pema Shelri,

abode of Lord Amitabha (3) Rewo Tala, the abode of Lord Avaloketeshwra and (4) Dewa Kota, the abode of three Kayas, Dharma Kaya, Sambhog Kaya and Nirmana Kaya.

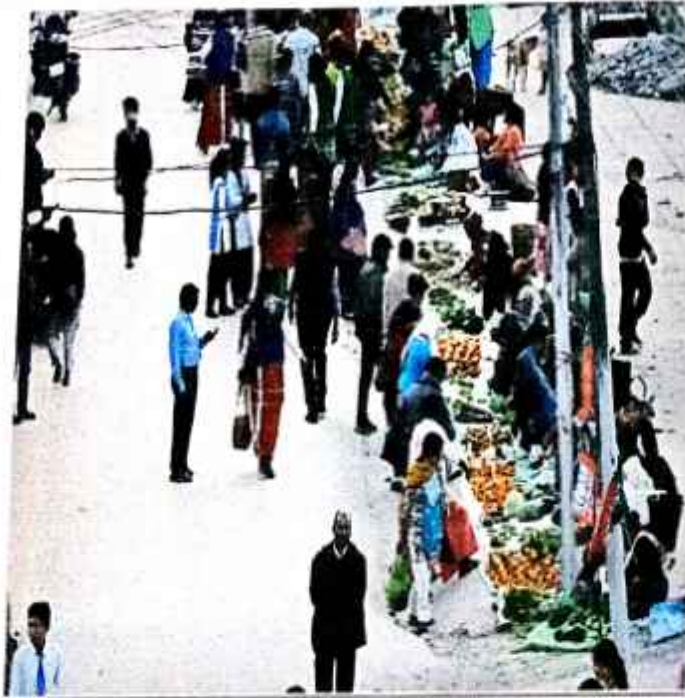
Tsitapuri Lake: - The famous Tsitapuri lake is one of the major tourist attraction. It is located in Tuting sub-division at a distance of 4 days foot march from Tuting town.

Water sports: - Water sports like river rafting, canoeing can be done at Siang River, one of the major Tourism festival is Siang River Festival that is held every year in January in all Siang district.



Pasighat- Jengging-Yingkiong tourist travel Circuit:- One of the approved tourist travel circuits of Arunachal Pradesh managed by the Director of Tourism, Itanagar in Arunachal Pradesh is Pasighat-Jengging-Yingkiong.

Population



As per 2011-Census the total population of Upper Siang is 35320, total male is 18699 and female is 16621. The Upper Siang has a Sex ratio of 888 females per 1000 males. The density of population is 5(five) persons per Sq. Km which is quite low as compared to 17 persons per Sq. Km. for Arunachal Pradesh. The decadal growth rate is 5.86% during the last decade (2001-2011).

Animal Husbandary and Veterinary

There are 8(Eight) veterinary Dispensaries and 4(four) veterinary Aid Centres, 3(Three) Cattle Upgrading centres, 1(one) Cattle breeding farms, 1(One) government fodder farms and 1(one) District Diagnostic

Laboratory in Upper Siang District during the year 2021-2022. The commonly reared domestic animal is pig. Mithun is the most common and dearest animal of the local people reared in semi-wild condition.

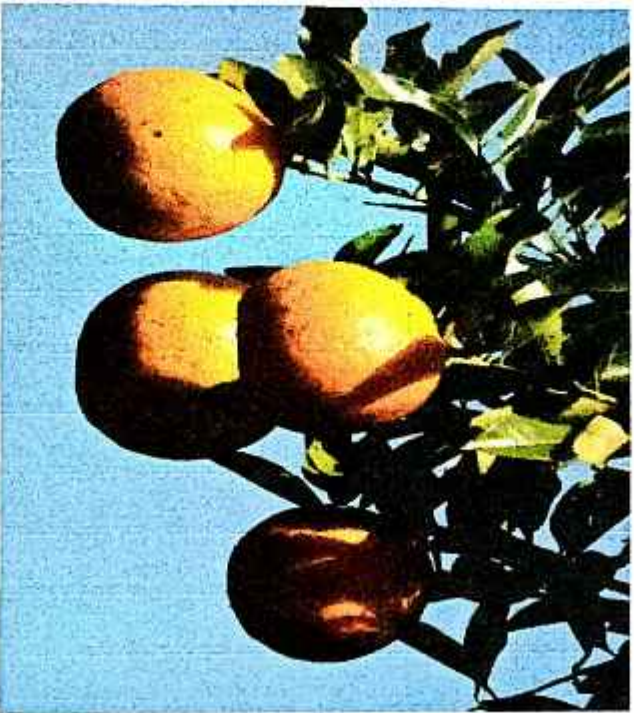
Agriculture

Agriculture is the main source of livelihood for the people of Upper Siang. The local practiced organic farming without use of fertilizer and pesticide. Jhum and shifting type of cultivation is prevalent throughout the district. Rice is the staple/main crop. Terrace cultivation is most common, irrigation is mainly through rain water, other than rice, maize, pulses, potato, oil seed, vegetables and chillies are also produced. Tea plantation is also being taken up in the district.



Education

Orange is the main horticultural crop with production of 3516 MT in the year 2020-21. The cultivation of pineapple, ginger and large cardamom in large scale is catching up in recent years. With the intimation of Department of Horticulture, Kiwi farming is quite popular in place like Gobuk.



Medical and Public health

In health care sector the Upper Siang in the year 2020-2021 have 1(one) district hospital at Yingkong and 4(four) Community Health Centre, 2(two) Primary Health Centre and 14(fourteen) Health Sub-Centre, 1(one) TB centre 1(one) Homeopathic Dispensary in Upper Siang. The district hospital have facilities for 50(fifty) indoor patient beds, altogether in whole district are 94 (Ninety four) numbers of authorized beds for indoor patient.



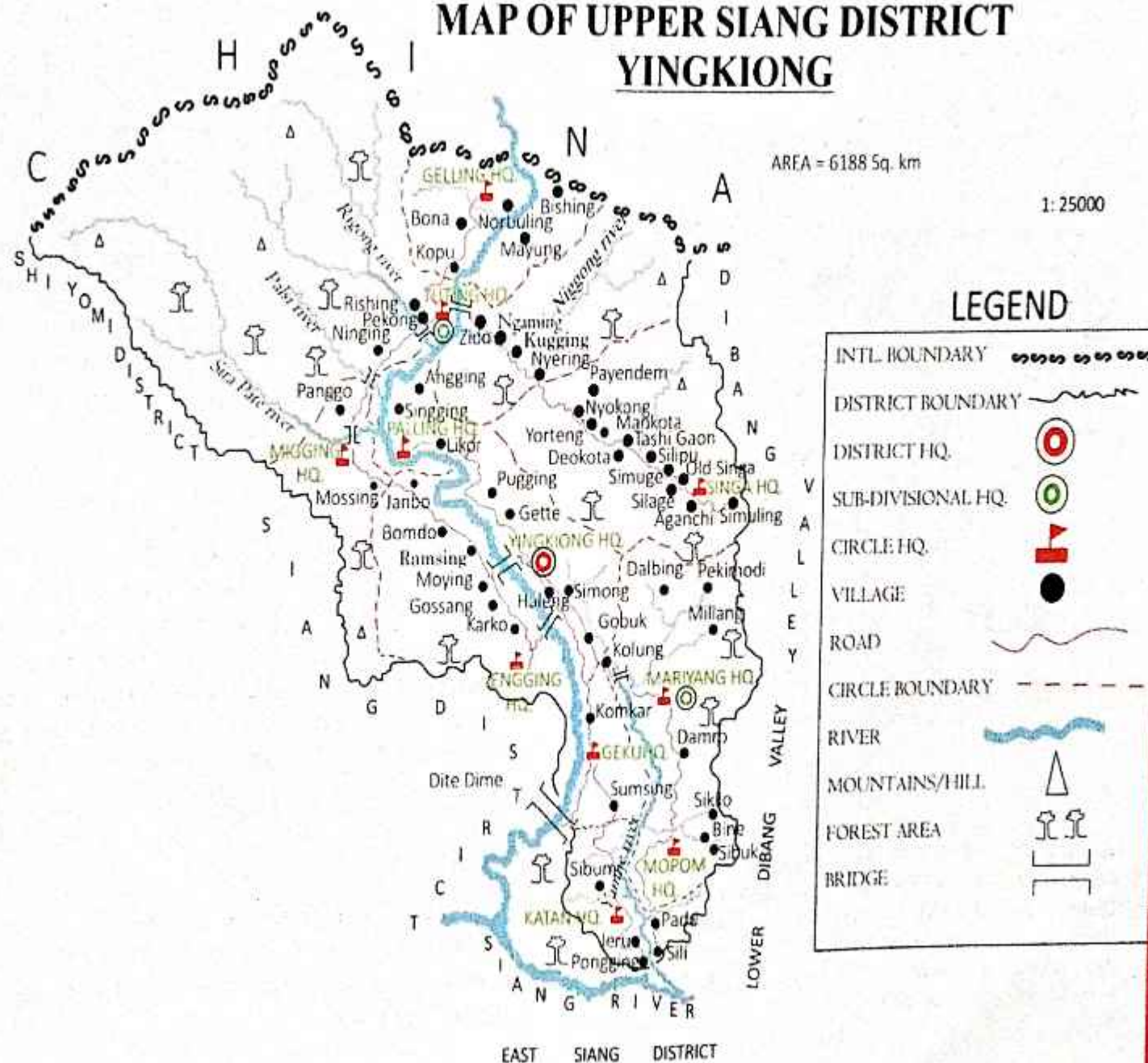
Education is the backbone of our society. It plays a vital role in social and economic upliftment. So far Upper Siang in the year 2020-2021 have 1(one) Collage, 5(five) higher secondary, 5(five) secondary, 28 (twenty eight) middle and 62(sixty two) primary schools, altogether 103 (one hundred three) Government educational institutions are functional. Numerous private schools are also functioning in the district that contributes immensely in imparting education to children of Upper Saing District. Several government aided girls residential schools are also operating smoothly. SSA and now RMSA play a vital role in achieving universalization of education in the district.

As per 2011 Census report, the literacy rate is 59.98% for Upper Siang District against the 66.95% of whole of Arunachal Pradesh. The literacy rate for female in Arunachal Pradesh is 44.31%(Rural) and that of Upper Siang is 52.63%.
