## GENERAL FEATURES OF ARUNACHAL PRADESH

1. *Arunachal Pradesh* : Arunachal Pradesh is situated in the North-Eastern part of India with 83743 sq. Km. in area Arunachal is the largest state area-wise in the North-East region.
2. *Location* : Between latitude 26° 28' N to 29° 30' N and Longitude 91° 30' E to 97° 30' E.
3. *Forest area* : 68, 847 Sq. Km. (82.21 %) of forest area in Arunachal Pradesh (as per Satellite Survey of December, 1988 to February, 1999).
4. *State Capital* : Itanagar (located at an altitude of 530 meter Above MSL). It is named after Itanfort meaning fort of bricks built in 14th century A.D.

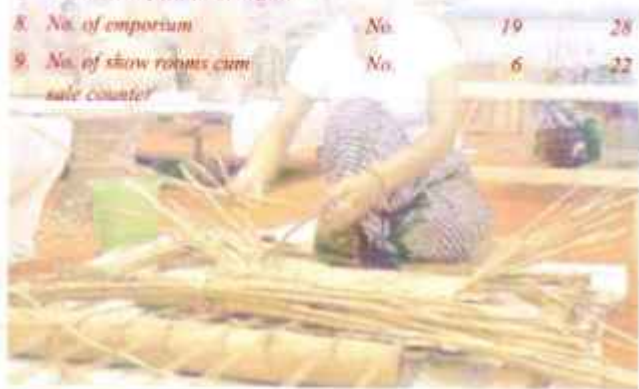
