Arunachal Pradesh



Arunachal Pradesh (literally meaning 'the land of Rising Sun') was known as the North-East Frontier Agency (NEFA) till 1972. It gained union territory Status on 20th January, 1972 and is renamed as 'Arunachal Pradesh'. Later, Arunachal Pradesh became full-fledged State on 20th February, 1987.

The present-day state of Arunachal Pradesh covers a geographical area of 83,743 sq. kms., which is roughly 2.55% of the total area of India. Forming India's International frontier with China and Tibet along with snow-clad mountains in the extreme north, the territory of Arunachal Pradesh extends its meeting point with Bhutan to the western direction for approximately 1030 kms in the eastern direction and then taking a turn to the south-east, it forms the border with Myanmar for about 441 kms., following the crest of the Patkoi ranges of mountains. The State has common border with Nagaland in the east and south-east and Assam in the south. Presently, there are 25 districts in the State.

The entire state of Arunachal Pradesh is almost wholly a rugged mountainous region with beautiful green valleys drained by innumerable rivulets and mighty cascading down from upper elevations. The mountains ranges are very steep with altitudes varying from 610 to 5,183 mts. The mountains descend into the plains westward through a number of hills, which constitute the highland. The Patkoi range has a number of passes across it, of which Pangsau Pass is very important. Arunachal Pradesh is drained by five major rivers – Kameng, Subansiri, Siang, Tirap and Lohit – and innumerable rivers and streams and many of them are snow-fed. The people have an innate knowledge of the environment and the cultural practices passed from generation to generation have help protect biodiversity of the region.



A place brimming with tremendous anthropological richness, the State is home to several groups of indigenous people. Broadly speaking there are three prominent school cultural belief groups; first being Monpas and Sherdukpen of Tawang and West Kameng districts who are followers of the tradition of Mahayana Buddhism. The second group comprising of Apatanis, Adis, Galos, Mishmis, Nyishis, Tagins, Akas etc worship the Sun and Moon God while the third group including Noctes, Wanchos and Khampti (tribal communities of TLCN – Tirap, Longding, Changlang, Namsai) follow basic Vaishnavism and Buddhism respectively and are ruled by a hereditary chief. Additionally, there are the Galo, Nyishi, Tagin, Apatani and Adi communities who are commonly known as Tani clans due to their connection with Abotani (abu/abo-father, tani-tribes) – from whom the mythical heritage of mankind’s origin is associated. Donyi-Poloism (Sun-Moon) is the philosophy of maintaining the balance of nature and harmony among tribals. Most of the tribes here worship nature, and other deities.

Arunachal us marked by linguistic heterogeneity and as many as 42 languages are spoken here. The tribes of Arunachal Pradesh are affiliated to the so-called Tibeto-Burmese group of languages. Assamese is spoken by most people since prolonged influence of the Ahom dynasty era. Hindi and English are currently the most widely spoken languages for people across the state, besides their own tribe’s language.

There seems to be no source of written records of Arunachal Pradesh’s culture and most of the information can be found through oral literature only. An enchanting abode of some of the world’s most unique communities, an abundance of rich biodiversity and a world set apart in time, Arunachal Pradesh is truly a paradise that will forever remain a blissful place, unspoiled by the passage of time.



The climate of Arunachal Pradesh varies from hot and humid to heavy rainfall in the Siwalik range. It became progressively cold as one moves northward higher altitudes. Trees of great size, plentiful climbers and abundance of cane and bamboo make Arunachal evergreen. The richness of flora and fauna that occur in these forests presents a panorama of biological diversity with over 5000 plant species, about 85 terrestrial mammals, over 500 birds and a large number of butterflies, insects and reptiles. Arunachal Pradesh also is considered to be a treasure home to orchids, known for their exquisitely beautiful blooms, with more than six hundred species occurring in varying elevations and climatic conditions throughout the state.

The State is also endowed with local arts & craft skills; thus we find exquisite carpets, painted wooden vessels and silver articles furniture from cane and bamboo, shawls and jackets, shoulder bags and ivory, boar's tusks, beads of agate, paper making etc.. Important festivals are Dree, Losar, Nyokum, Boori Boot, Si- Donyi, Mopin, Oriah, Solung, Tamladu and so on. The nature has blessed the people of Arunachal Pradesh with deep sense of beauty which find delightful expression in their folk songs, dances, craft and festivals.
